Introduction for people who are Deaf or hard of hearing

This show is Deaf / hard of hearing friendly. We'd love to tell you a little bit more about the show and the times where we, the performers, do use our voices and some sound effects.

A visual show

We are 3 jugglers that use our artform of juggling and physical theatre to tell a story. In this show, we use juggling and our objects in physical and figurative ways to drive the story. We juggle to music to keep us in tune with each other but we hope that you can feel the music through our juggling. Otherwise enjoy a visual spectacle and join us on a journey to save the world.

Why we sometimes use our voices/sound effects

The show is meant to be visual, but we sometimes use voices and sound effects. For most of the show there is almost no talking but in one instance the darkness there will be moments of "walking into our sets" creating noises. We also have a moment of 'Marco Polo' in the darkness but this will be tied to a visual of turning on our flashlights. All of the sound effects in the show are either combined with action or with set pieces changing light settings.

Curtain speech

Before the show there will be a short speech by someone from the festival. A curtain speech. What is the speech about? It always starts with acknowledging that we are on Indigenous lands and what that means. That person will also thank sponsors, volunteers, donors etc. They might talk about another show or other things happening at the festival.
